

Monitoring resource consumption at QIC is an important part of the Company's sustainable development policy, as it allows tracking the efficiency of energy, water, paper, and other resource use, as well as identifying opportunities to improve resource efficiency.

It should be noted that the indicators for electricity consumption, water use, and waste volumes are outside QIC's direct control, as the office premises are leased and the data for these indicators is provided by the landlord. Values may vary depending on external factors such as seasonality, staff numbers, and building-specific conditions.

At the same time, even maintaining the current level of resource consumption can be considered a form of reduction. This is because, given the natural growth of office activities, changes in staff numbers, or seasonal fluctuations, the indicators could increase without oversight. Maintaining the indicators at the baseline level means that QIC aims to support efficient resource use and prevent increases in environmental load. This approach demonstrates tangible efforts to reduce environmental impact, even when direct reductions are challenging due to the characteristics of leased premises.
